Hosting an Ancient Paths Event!

Greetings and grace to you! Thank you for your willingness to host an Ancient Paths Event in your area. The following information explains how your fellowship can team together with Family Foundations International (FFI) to advance the Kingdom, bringing healing and blessing to God's people, through these life-changing events.

Hosting an Event requires minimal financial commitment from the host. Expenses incurred by Family Foundations in bringing an Event to you are offset by the following:

Seminar Income

- All Ancient Paths participants are encouraged to pre-register, with registration fees paid in advance.
- In addition, books and audio/video teachings will be offered at a materials resource center which is made available during all Events.
- Finally, once during each Event, participants are provided an opportunity to partner (Phil. 1:5) with FFI through a love offering for the expansion of FFI's ministry.

Hospitality

Family Foundations requests that hosts provide:

- 1) Housing and meals for out-of-town seminar Coordinators and Facilitators (either in the homes of members, or in a local hotel/motel).
- 2) Adequate meeting facilities with audio-visual equipment to show the videos/DVDs.
- 3) Enough private rooms to accommodate small groups (of approximately 6-10 people) separately.
- 4) A box of facial tissues for each small group.
- 5) Snacks during breaks and optional Saturday continental breakfast.
- 6) An Event contact person who will organize all pre-registration forms and payment and work with the Family Foundations Event Coordinator in planning the success of the Event.

Schedule

FFI has found that participants receive maximum benefit when they experience the entire Event. Each teaching builds on the one before, so it is important that all registrants attend every session. Registrants not attending the first Event session will be asked to wait for the next available Event to participate.

Please note:

- *The minimum number of participants is flexible and will be determined between the pastor/leader and the Event Coordinator conducting the Event.*
- *The host is to choose three possible dates in order to determine one that works best for both parties.*
- *If extensive travel arrangements need to be made (e.g. airline reservations), hosts may be requested to make a small deposit to offset initial expenses.*

Equipping Local Leaders for Ministry

Ancient Paths Events

The following guideline explains how it is possible to raise up a local team in order to offer Family Foundations Events to your fellowship on an ongoing basis. Please discuss with your Seminar Coordinator how to tailor this plan to your needs and vision.

- Event I** Family Foundations brings a ministry team to your facility, where they will conduct an Ancient Paths Event. The participants should be selected by the pastor and have potential to become facilitators.
- Training I** Family Foundations conducts a training session for members and/or others who have attended the first Event and are good candidates for becoming small group facilitators. This training takes place approximately one week before a second Event. Family Foundations will work closely with the pastor to identify these individuals.
- Event II** Approximately four to six weeks after the first Event, Family Foundations brings a ministry team to conduct a second Event using facilitators from your congregation.
- Training II** Family Foundations trains another group of local facilitators.
- Event III** Approximately another four to six weeks later, a third Ancient Paths Event is conducted, in which Family Foundations sends an Event Coordinator to your congregation teaming with the newly trained local facilitators.
- Event IV** The last Event is a "graduate" course called Ancient Paths: Transforming Hearts (*Ancient Paths Level II Event*), which builds on the material presented in the first Event. After this Event, Family Foundations works together with the local pastor/leader to qualify, designate and train an Event Coordinator, now enabled to administrate in-house Events on an ongoing basis.
